History of the Stations of the Cross

The First Stations of the Cross were developed by St. Francis of Assisi. In 1686, Pope Innocent XI gave the Franciscan Monks permission to place the stations in all of their churches. The devotion spread and soon the stations could be found in every church. 14 Stations became the standard number in the devotion. In recent years, many have advocated for and/or added a 15th station depicting the resurrection of Jesus.
