The Honor Flight Program arranges for a day long trip to Washington DC for the veteran and a guardian. Round trip flight from T.F. Green Airport to Baltimore Washington International Airport, transports to Arlington National Cemetery, the World War II Memorial, the Korean Memorial, and the Vietnam Memorial. Meals, souvenirs and commemorative coins are all part of a day to remember. The day long (*5am departure from Warwick with a late arrival back home*) and full, but with the assistance of a "guardian" (*usually a family member*) to accompany and see to any and all needs of the traveling veteran, is a celebration that will provide new and lasting memories.
