## LENTEN REFLECTION: PASSION (PALM) SUNDAY

The last Sunday before Holy Week is celebrated with the blessing and distribution of Palms or other branches in areas where palms are not readily available. A church in Florida asks their parishioners to bring palms from their own yards. They are then Blessed during the Mass. Usually there is a procession with children and adults carrying palms into the church, in memory of the day that Jesus rode into Jerusalem and crowds gathers, waved branches and proclaimed him King. In the past, Passion Sunday was observed on the second Sunday before Holy Week, but today Passion and Palm Sunday are combined to begin the week of Jesus' Passion. This very Holy Week, let us spend a few moments a day meditating on how we can be a little kinder, less judgmental, more patient, less selfish & more selfless to others. Let us give thanks for the blessings we have, rather than lament on what we don't have.
