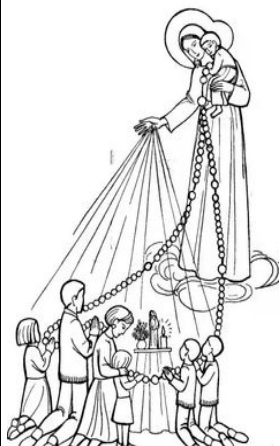

**GIVE A KID A COAT!!!!**

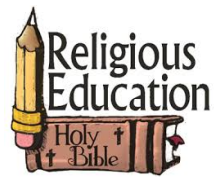
