



Feed a Child Program, Public Health Outreach, providing care to people in 35 villages, St. Pius Village adjacent to the Clinic, housing blind, elderly, orphaned and disabled people who are homeless. School of Nursing which graduates 30 or more nurses each year. Happy House Program replacing small shacks of cardboard and straw with clean, temen houses with tin roofs, windows and doors. There have been several hundred built to date. You can have a house built and a plaque will be placed on the house with your name on it, or if you wish, in memory of loved ones. 
