There will be sessions focusing on numerous topics relating to Unity, Renewal, Missionary Discipleship, Witness and Evangelization. Bishop Edgar M. da Cunha is pleased to have 15 people from the diocese joining him for this unique and enriching meeting. You are invited to join the diocesan delegation in prayer, as they prepare to represent the diocese at the various events and sessions.
