With this insight, he joined the priesthood. On a trip to Rome, he and his companions started the Society of Jesus, an Order under the service to the Pope. Members, called Jesuits, traveled wherever help was needed and Ignatius was their first Superior. Today the Society of Jesus has over 25,000 Jesuits scattered around the world. They are affiliated with 28 U.S. Colleges and 46 secondary schools. Their ministries are not only for the clergy.
